JOINT RESOLUTION

Approving the renewal of import restrictions contained in
the Burmese Freedom and Democracy Act of 2003.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. RENEWAL OF IMPORT RESTRICTIONS UNDER**
2 **BURMESE FREEDOM AND DEMOCRACY ACT**
3 **OF 2003.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Congress approves the renewal of
5 the import restrictions contained in section 3(a)(1) and
6 section 3A (b)(1) and (c)(1) of the Burmese Freedom and
7 Democracy Act of 2003.

8 (b) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—This joint resolution
9 shall be deemed to be a “renewal resolution” for purposes
10 of section 9 of the Burmese Freedom and Democracy Act
11 of 2003.

12 **SEC. 2. PAYGO COMPLIANCE.**

13 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of
14 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010,
15 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
16 titled “Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation” for this
17 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record
18 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro-
19 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the
20 vote on passage.

21 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

22 This joint resolution shall take effect on the date of
23 the enactment of this joint resolution or July 26, 2011,
24 whichever occurs earlier.
