Ms. FOXX, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

**RESOLUTION**

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1947) to provide for the reform and continuation of agricultural and other programs of the Department of Agriculture through fiscal year 2018, and for other purposes; and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1797) to amend title 18, United States Code, to protect pain-capable unborn children in the District of Columbia, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1947) to provide for the reform  
6 and continuation of agricultural and other programs of the  
7 Department of Agriculture through fiscal year 2018, and  
8 for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be  
9 dispensed with. All points of order against consideration  
10 of the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined  
11 to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided  
12 and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member  
13 of the Committee on Agriculture. After general debate, the  
14 Committee of the Whole shall rise without motion. No fur-  
15 ther consideration of the bill shall be in order except pur-  
16 suant to a subsequent order of the House.

17       SEC. 2. Upon the adoption of this resolution it shall  
18 be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 1797)  
19 to amend title 18, United States Code, to protect pain-  
20 capable unborn children in the District of Columbia, and  
21 for other purposes. All points of order against consider-  
22 ation of the bill are waived. In lieu of the amendment in  
23 the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee  
24 on the Judiciary now printed in the bill, an amendment  
25 in the nature of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules

1 Committee Print 113-15 shall be considered as adopted.  
2 The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. All  
3 points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended,  
4 are waived. The previous question shall be considered as  
5 ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any amendment  
6 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except:  
7 (1) one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by  
8 the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee  
9 on the Judiciary; and (2) one motion to recommit with  
10 or without instructions.
