**RESOLUTION**

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 899) to provide for additional safeguards with respect to imposing Federal mandates, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this reso-  
2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule  
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of  
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 899) to provide for additional safe-  
6 guards with respect to imposing Federal mandates, and  
7 for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be

1 dispensed with. All points of order against consideration  
2 of the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined  
3 to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided  
4 and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member  
5 of the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform.  
6 After general debate the bill shall be considered for  
7 amendment under the five-minute rule. The bill shall be  
8 considered as read. All points of order against provisions  
9 in the bill are waived. No amendment to the bill shall be  
10 in order except those printed in the report of the Com-  
11 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each such  
12 amendment may be offered only in the order printed in  
13 the report, may be offered only by a Member designated  
14 in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debat-  
15 able for the time specified in the report equally divided  
16 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall  
17 not be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to  
18 a demand for division of the question in the House or in  
19 the Committee of the Whole. All points of order against  
20 such amendments are waived. At the conclusion of consid-  
21 eration of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise  
22 and report the bill to the House with such amendments  
23 as may have been adopted. The previous question shall  
24 be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments

- 1 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
- 2 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
