**RESOLUTION**

Providing for further consideration of the bill (H.R. 5) to support State and local accountability for public education, protect State and local authority, inform parents of the performance of their children's schools, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this reso-  
2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule  
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of  
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for further  
5 consideration of the bill (H.R. 5) to support State and

1 local accountability for public education, protect State and  
2 local authority, inform parents of the performance of their  
3 children's schools, and for other purposes. No further gen-  
4 eral debate shall be in order. In lieu of the amendment  
5 in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Com-  
6 mittee on Education and the Workforce now printed in  
7 the bill, an amendment in the nature of a substitute con-  
8 sisting of the text of Rules Committee Print 114-8, modi-  
9 fied by the amendment printed in part A of the report  
10 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution,  
11 shall be considered as adopted in the House and in the  
12 Committee of the Whole. The bill, as amended, shall be  
13 considered as the original bill for the purpose of further  
14 amendment under the five-minute rule and shall be consid-  
15 ered as read. All points of order against provisions in the  
16 bill, as amended, are waived. No further amendment to  
17 the bill, as amended, shall be in order except those printed  
18 in part B of the report of the Committee on Rules. Each  
19 such further amendment shall be considered only in the  
20 order printed in the report, may be offered only by a Mem-  
21 ber designated in the report, shall be considered as read,  
22 shall be debatable for the time specified in the report  
23 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an  
24 opponent, may be withdrawn by its proponent at any time  
25 before action thereon, shall not be subject to amendment,

1 and shall not be subject to a demand for division of the  
2 question in the House or in the Committee of the Whole.  
3 All points of order against such further amendments are  
4 waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for  
5 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill,  
6 as amended, to the House with such further amendments  
7 as may have been adopted. The previous question shall  
8 be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and any  
9 further amendment thereto to final passage without inter-  
10 vening motion except one motion to recommit with or  
11 without instructions.
