

Amendment by Mr. COLE of Oklahoma

At the appropriate place, insert the following:

XX. It shall not be in order for the committee to grant a rule for consideration of a bill, joint resolution or concurrent resolution if it fails to provide for consideration for at least one minority amendment if the rule provides for consideration of at least one majority amendment that is self-executed.

For purposes of this section a “minority amendment” is defined as an amendment that –

- (1) Is properly submitted to the committee by the ranking minority member of the primary committee of jurisdiction for the measure under consideration by the announced deadline;
- (2) Has no cosponsors from a member of the Democratic Caucus; and,
- (3) Does not requires waivers of either the Rules of the House or the Congressional Budget and Impoundment Control Act of 1974 to provide for its consideration.
