

SECTION-BY-SECTION SUMMARY OF RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 115-52

**TEXT OF THE HOUSE AMENDMENT TO THE
SENATE AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1370**

DIVISION A

Sec. 1001. Continues funding for the government through January 19, 2018. Includes anomalies related to Coast Guard continuation pay, Indian Health Service, Unaccompanied Alien Children, influenza pandemic, and delay of sequestration for defense and non-defense.

Sec. 1002. Continues the authorization for FISA through the date of the continuing resolution.

DIVISION B

TITLE I

Provides for the necessary costs to repair damages to two naval ships as requested by the Administration and the Department of Defense.

Provides for the necessary costs to detect, defeat and defend against the use of ballistic missiles as requested by the Administration and the Department of Defense.

TITLE II

Provides for the construction of a missile field in Alaska as requested by the Administration.

DIVISION C

Sec. 3101. Authorizes \$550 million for Community Health Centers, \$65 million for the National Health Service Corps, and an additional \$15 million for the Teaching Health Center Graduate Medical Education Program for the first and second quarters of fiscal year 2018.

Sec. 3102. Authorizes \$37.5 million for the Special Diabetes Program for Type 1 Diabetes for the first and second quarters of fiscal year 2018; and \$37.5 million for the Special Diabetes Program for Indians for the second quarter of fiscal year 2018.

Sec. 3103. Redirects \$750 million from the Prevention and Public Health Fund (PPHF) to support the extension of funding for these critically-important public health programs that expand access to care and improve health outcomes.

Sec. 3201. Provides for the Children's Health Insurance Program \$2.85 billion for the first two quarters of FY2018 (October 1, 2017 through March 31, 2018) with certain conditions and

extends, with some modifications, a current law provision for Q1 and Q2 of FY2018 that gave CMS more flexibility over the use of Redistribution Funds to provide to states.

DIVISION D

Sec. 4001. Provides \$2.1 billion in mandatory funding for the Veterans Choice program.

DIVISION E

Sec. 5001. Provides instructions for the treatment of divisions C and D as it relates to PAYGO, Senate PAYGO, and scorekeeping guidelines.

Sec. 5002. Provides instructions for the treatment of the Reconciliation Act as it relates to the PAYGO scorecard.
