A BILL

To require the Director of the Bureau of Land Management to withdraw a rule of the Bureau of Land Management relating to conservation and landscape health.

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the "Western Economic Security Today Act of 20232024" or the "WEST Act of 20232024".

SEC. 2. WITHDRAWAL OF BLM PROPOSED RULE.

The Director of the Bureau of Land Management-

(1) shall withdraw the proposed rule of the Bureau of Land Management entitled "Conservation and Landscape Health" (88 Fed. Reg. 19583 (April 3, 2023)); and

(2) shall not take any action to finalize, implement, or enforce the proposed rule described in paragraph (1) or any substantially similar rule.

SEC. 2. WITHDRAWAL OF BLM RULE.

<u>The final rule based on the proposed rule of the Bureau of Land Management entitled "Conservation and</u> Landscape Health" (88 Fed. Reg. 19583 (April 3, 2023)) shall have no force or effect.
