Mr. BURGESS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2666) to prohibit the Federal Communications Commission from regulating the rates charged for broadband Internet access service.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this reso-
2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2666) to prohibit the Federal Com-
6 munications Commission from regulating the rates

1 charged for broadband Internet access service. The first
2 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of
3 order against consideration of the bill are waived. General
4 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed
5 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair and
6 ranking minority member of the Committee on Energy
7 and Commerce. After general debate the bill shall be con-
8 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall
9 be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose
10 of amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment
11 in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Com-
12 mittee on Energy and Commerce now printed in the bill.
13 The committee amendment in the nature of a substitute
14 shall be considered as read. All points of order against
15 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute
16 are waived. No amendment to the committee amendment
17 in the nature of a substitute shall be in order except those
18 printed in the report of the Committee on Rules accom-
19 panying this resolution. Each such amendment may be of-
20 fered only in the order printed in the report, may be of-
21 fered only by a Member designated in the report, shall
22 be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time spec-
23 ified in the report equally divided and controlled by the
24 proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amend-
25 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division

1 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the
2 Whole. All points of order against such amendments are
3 waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for
4 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill
5 to the House with such amendments as may have been
6 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the
7 House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of
8 the Whole to the bill or to the committee amendment in
9 the nature of a substitute. The previous question shall be
10 considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto
11 to final passage without intervening motion except one
12 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
