## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2745) to amend the Clayton Act and the Federal Trade Commission Act to provide that the Federal Trade Commission shall exercise authority with respect to mergers only under the Clayton Act and only in the same procedural manner as the Attorney General exercises such authority, and providing for proceedings during the period from March 24, 2016, through April 11, 2016.

1       *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it  
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
3 2745) to amend the Clayton Act and the Federal Trade  
4 Commission Act to provide that the Federal Trade Com-  
5 mission shall exercise authority with respect to mergers  
6 only under the Clayton Act and only in the same proce-  
7 dural manner as the Attorney General exercises such au-  
8 thority. All points of order against consideration of the  
9 bill are waived. The bill shall be considered as read. All  
10 points of order against provisions in the bill are waived.  
11 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on  
12 the bill and on any amendment thereto to final passage  
13 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate  
14 equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking  
15 minority member of the Committee on the Judiciary; and  
16 (2) one motion to recommit.

17       SEC. 2. On any legislative day during the period from  
18 March 24, 2016, through April 11, 2016—

19       (a) the Journal of the proceedings of the previous day  
20 shall be considered as approved; and

21       (b) the Chair may at any time declare the House ad-  
22 journed to meet at a date and time, within the limits of  
23 clause 4, section 5, article I of the Constitution, to be an-  
24 nounced by the Chair in declaring the adjournment.

1       SEC. 3. The Speaker may appoint Members to per-  
2 form the duties of the Chair for the duration of the period  
3 addressed by section 2 of this resolution as though under  
4 clause 8(a) of rule I.

5       SEC. 4. Each day during the period addressed by sec-  
6 tion 2 of this resolution shall not constitute a calendar  
7 day for purposes of section 7 of the War Powers Resolu-  
8 tion (50 U.S.C. 1546).

9       SEC. 5. The Committee on Energy and Commerce  
10 may, at any time before 4 p.m. on Thursday, March 31,  
11 2016, file a report to accompany H.R. 2666.
