Ms. FOXX, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the Senate amendment to the House amendment to the bill (S. 764) to reauthorize and amend the National Sea Grant College Program Act, and for other purposes; providing for consideration of the bill (S. 304) to improve motor vehicle safety by encouraging the sharing of certain information; and waiving a requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII with respect to consideration of certain resolutions reported from the Committee on Rules.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill
3 (S. 764) to reauthorize and amend the National Sea Grant
4 College Program Act, and for other purposes, with the
5 Senate amendment to the House amendment thereto, and
6 to consider in the House, without intervention of any point
7 of order, a motion offered by the chair of the Committee
8 on Agriculture or his designee that the House concur in
9 the Senate amendment to the House amendment. The
10 Senate amendment and the motion shall be considered as
11 read. The motion shall be debatable for one hour equally
12 divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
13 member of the Committee on Agriculture. The previous
14 question shall be considered as ordered on the motion to
15 adoption without intervening motion.

16 SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be
17 in order to consider in the House the bill (S. 304) to im-
18 prove motor vehicle safety by encouraging the sharing of
19 certain information. All points of order against consider-
20 ation of the bill are waived. An amendment in the nature
21 of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Committee
22 Print 114-61 shall be considered as adopted. The bill, as
23 amended, shall be considered as read. All points of order
24 against provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. The
25 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the

1 bill, as amended, and on any further amendment thereto,
2 to final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one
3 hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair
4 and ranking minority member of the Committee on En-
5 ergy and Commerce; and (2) one motion to recommit with
6 or without instructions.

7 SEC. 3. The requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII
8 for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the Com-
9 mittee on Rules on the same day it is presented to the
10 House is waived with respect to any resolution reported
11 on the legislative day of July 14, 2016, or July 15, 2016.
