RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the conference report to accompany the bill (H.R. 5515) to authorize appropriations for fiscal year 2019 for military activities of the Department of Defense, for military construction, and for defense activities of the Department of Energy, to prescribe military personnel strengths for such fiscal year, and for other purposes.

- 1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider the conference report to ac-
3 company the bill (H.R. 5515) to authorize appropriations

1 for fiscal year 2019 for military activities of the Depart-
2 ment of Defense, for military construction, and for defense
3 activities of the Department of Energy, to prescribe mili-
4 tary personnel strengths for such fiscal year, and for other
5 purposes. All points of order against the conference report
6 and against its consideration are waived. The conference
7 report shall be considered as read. The previous question
8 shall be considered as ordered on the conference report
9 to its adoption without intervening motion except: (1) one
10 hour of debate; and (2) one motion to recommit if applica-
11 ble.

13 any time before 3 p.m. on Thursday, August 2, 2018, file
14 privileged reports to accompany measures making appro-
15 priations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019.
