Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2581) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to require the provision of social security numbers as a condition of receiving the health insurance premium tax credit, and providing for consideration of the bill (S. 1094) to amend title 38, United States Code, to improve the accountability of employees of the Department of Veterans Affairs, and for other purposes. 2

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it 2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 3 2581) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to 4 require the provision of social security numbers as a condi-5 tion of receiving the health insurance premium tax credit. All points of order against consideration of the bill are 6 7 waived. The amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-8 ommended by the Committee on Ways and Means now 9 printed in the bill shall be considered as adopted. The bill, 10 as amended, shall be considered as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are 11 waived. The previous question shall be considered as or-12 13 dered on the bill, as amended, and on any further amendment thereto, to final passage without intervening motion 14 15 except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the 16 Committee on Ways and Means; and (2) one motion to 17 18 recommit with or without instructions.

19 SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be 20 in order to consider in the House the bill (S. 1094) to 21 amend title 38, United States Code, to improve the ac-22 countability of employees of the Department of Veterans 23 Affairs, and for other purposes. All points of order against 24 consideration of the bill are waived. The bill shall be con-25 sidered as read. All points of order against provisions in 3

the bill are waived. The previous question shall be consid ered as ordered on the bill and on any amendment thereto
to final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one
hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair
and ranking minority member of the Committee on Vet erans' Affairs; and (2) one motion to commit.
