Mr. BUCK of Colorado, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2851) to amend the Controlled Substances Act to clarify how controlled substance analogues are to be regulated, and for other purposes; providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5735) to amend the United States Housing Act of 1937

to establish a demonstration program to set aside section 8 housing vouchers for supportive and transitional housing for individuals recovering from opioid use disorders or other substance use disorders, and for other purposes; and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5788) to provide for the processing by U.S. Customs and Border Protection of certain international mail shipments and to require the provision of advance electronic information on international mail shipments of mail, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this reso-2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule 3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-4 ation of the bill (H.R. 2851) to amend the Controlled Sub-5 stances Act to clarify how controlled substance analogues 6 7 are to be regulated, and for other purposes. The first read-8 ing of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order 9 against consideration of the bill are waived. General de-10 bate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair and rank-11 12 ing minority member of the Committee on the Judiciary. 13 After general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute rule. In lieu of the 14 15 amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on the Judiciary, it shall be in order to 16 consider as an original bill for the purpose of amendment 17

under the five-minute rule an amendment in the nature 1 2 of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Committee 3 Print 115-74. That amendment in the nature of a sub-4 stitute shall be considered as read. All points of order 5 against that amendment in the nature of a substitute are 6 waived. No amendment to that amendment in the nature 7 of a substitute shall be in order except those printed in 8 part A of the report of the Committee on Rules accom-9 panying this resolution. Each such amendment may be of-10 fered only in the order printed in the report, may be offered only by a Member designated in the report, shall 11 be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time spec-12 13 ified in the report equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amend-14 15 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division of the question in the House or in the Committee of the 16 Whole. All points of order against such amendments are 17 waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for 18 19 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with such amendments as may have been 20 21 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of 22 23 the Whole to the bill or to the amendment in the nature 24 of a substitute made in order as original text. The previous 25 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and

amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
motion except one motion to recommit with or without in structions.

4 SEC. 2. At any time after adoption of this resolution 5 the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of the 6 7 Whole House on the state of the Union for consideration 8 of the bill (H.R. 5735) to amend the United States Hous-9 ing Act of 1937 to establish a demonstration program to 10 set aside section 8 housing vouchers for supportive and transitional housing for individuals recovering from opioid 11 12 use disorders or other substance use disorders, and for 13 other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consideration of 14 15 the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and 16 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of 17 the Committee on Financial Services. After general debate 18 the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-19 minute rule. In lieu of the amendments recommended by 20 21 the Committee on Financial Services now printed in the 22 bill, it shall be in order to consider as an original bill for 23 the purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule an 24 amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Committee Print 115-73. That amendment 25

in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as read. 1 2 All points of order against that amendment in the nature of a substitute are waived. No amendment to that amend-3 4 ment in the nature of a substitute shall be in order except 5 those printed in part B of the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each such amend-6 7 ment may be offered only in the order printed in the re-8 port, may be offered only by a Member designated in the 9 report, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for 10 the time specified in the report equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be 11 12 subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a de-13 mand for division of the question in the House or in the 14 Committee of the Whole. All points of order against such 15 amendments are waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise 16 17 and report the bill to the House with such amendments 18 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted 19 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the amend-20 21 ment in the nature of a substitute made in order as origi-22 nal text. The previous question shall be considered as or-23 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage 24 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit with or without instructions. 25

1 SEC. 3. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 5788) 2 3 to provide for the processing by U.S. Customs and Border 4 Protection of certain international mail shipments and to require the provision of advance electronic information on 5 international mail shipments of mail, and for other pur-6 7 poses. All points of order against consideration of the bill 8 are waived. In lieu of the amendment in the nature of a 9 substitute recommended by the Committee on Ways and 10 Means now printed in the bill, the amendment in the nature of a substitute printed in part C of the report of the 11 12 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution, modi-13 fied by the amendment printed in part D of that report, shall be considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall 14 15 be considered as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous 16 17 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further amendment thereto, to final 18 19 passage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour 20 of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and 21 ranking minority member of the Committee on Ways and 22 Means; and (2) one motion to recommit with or without 23 instructions.
