All points of order against 4 consideration of the bill are waived. The bill shall be con-5 sidered as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill are waived. The previous question shall be consid-6 7 ered as ordered on the bill and on any amendment thereto 8 to final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one 9 hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on the 10 Judiciary; and (2) one motion to recommit. 11

SEC. 2. On any legislative day during the period from
January 22, 2018, through January 26, 2018—

(a) the Journal of the proceedings of the previous dayshall be considered as approved; and

(b) the Chair may at any time declare the House adjourned to meet at a date and time, within the limits of
clause 4, section 5, article I of the Constitution, to be announced by the Chair in declaring the adjournment.

SEC. 3. The Speaker may appoint Members to perform the duties of the Chair for the duration of the period
addressed by section 2 of this resolution as though under
clause 8(a) of rule I.
