Mr. NEWHOUSE, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

**RESOLUTION**

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5444) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to modernize and improve the Internal Revenue Service, and for other purposes, and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5445) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to improve cybersecurity and taxpayer identity protection, and modernize the information technology of the Internal Revenue Service, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it  
2 shall be in order to consider in the House any bill specified  
3 in section 2 of this resolution. All points of order against  
4 consideration of each such bill are waived. The respective  
5 amendments in the nature of a substitute recommended  
6 by the Committee on Ways and Means now printed in each  
7 such bill shall be considered as adopted. Each such bill,  
8 as amended, shall be considered as read. All points of  
9 order against provisions in each such bill, as amended, are  
10 waived. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
11 dered on each such bill, as amended, and on any further  
12 amendment thereto, to final passage without intervening  
13 motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and  
14 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of  
15 the Committee on Ways and Means; and (2) one motion  
16 to recommit with or without instructions.

17       SEC. 2. The bills referred to in the first section of  
18 this resolution are as follows:

19               (a) The bill (H.R. 5444) to amend the Internal  
20 Revenue Code of 1986 to modernize and improve the  
21 Internal Revenue Service, and for other purposes.

22               (b) The bill (H.R. 5445) to amend the Internal  
23 Revenue Code of 1986 to improve cybersecurity and  
24 taxpayer identity protection, and modernize the in-

1       formation technology of the Internal Revenue Serv-  
2       ice, and for other purposes.

3       SEC. 3. (a) In the engrossment of H.R. 5444, the  
4 Clerk shall—

5           (1) await the disposition of H.R. 2901, H.R.  
6       5437, H.R. 5438, H.R. 5439, H.R. 5440, H.R.  
7       5443, H.R. 5445, and H.R. 5446;

8           (2) add the respective texts of all the bills speci-  
9       fied in paragraph (1), as passed by the House, as  
10      new matter at the end of H.R. 5444;

11          (3) conform the title of H.R. 5444 to reflect the  
12      addition to the engrossment of the text of all the  
13      bills specified in paragraph (1) that have passed the  
14      House;

15          (4) assign appropriate designations to provi-  
16      sions within the engrossment; and

17          (5) conform cross-references and provisions for  
18      short titles within the engrossment.

19      (b) Upon the addition to the engrossment of H.R.  
20      5444 of the text of the bills specified in subsection (a)(1)  
21      that have passed the House, such bills shall be laid on  
22      the table.
