8 SEC. 2. (a) No further amendment to the bill, as 9 amended, shall be in order except those printed in the re-10 port of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution and amendments en bloc described in section 3 of this 11 12 resolution. (b) Each further amendment printed in the re-13 port of the Committee on Rules shall be considered only in the order printed in the report, may be offered only 14 15 by a Member designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time specified in the 16 report equally divided and controlled by the proponent and 17 an opponent, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall 18 not be subject to a demand for division of the question 19 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. (c) All 20 21 points of order against the further amendments printed 22 in the report of the Committee on Rules or amendments en bloc described in section 3 of this resolution are waived. 23 24 SEC. 3. It shall be in order at any time for the chair

25 of the Committee on Armed Services or his designee to

offer amendments en bloc consisting of amendments print-1 2 ed in the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying 3 this resolution not earlier disposed of. Amendments en 4 bloc offered pursuant to this section shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for 20 minutes equally divided 5 and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member 6 of the Committee on Armed Services or their designees, 7 8 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be sub-9 ject to a demand for division of the question in the House 10 or in the Committee of the Whole.

11 SEC. 4. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment pursuant to this resolution the Committee 12 13 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such further amendments as may have been adopted. The previous 14 15 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without intervening 16 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-17 structions. 18

19 SEC. 5. On any legislative day during the period from 20 May 25, 2018, through June 4, 2018 -- (a) the Journal 21 of the proceedings of the previous day shall be considered 22 as approved; and (b) the Chair may at any time declare 23 the House adjourned to meet at a date and time, within 24 the limits of clause 4, section 5, article I of the Constitu4

1 tion, to be announced by the Chair in declaring the ad-2 journment.

3 SEC. 6. The Speaker may appoint Members to per-4 form the duties of the Chair for the duration of the period 5 addressed by section 5 of this resolution as though under 6 clause 8(a) of rule I.

SEC. 7. Each day during the period addressed by sec8 tion 5 of this resolution shall not constitute a calendar
9 day of continuous session for purposes of section 1017(b)
10 of the Congressional Budget and Impoundment Control
11 Act of 1974 (2 U.S.C. 688(b)).
