## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1398) to establish the CCP Initiative program, and for other purposes; providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1425) to

require any convention, agreement, or other international instrument on pandemic prevention, preparedness, and response reached by the World Health Assembly to be subject to Senate ratification; providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1516) to establish Department of Homeland Security funding restrictions on institutions of higher education that have a relationship with Confucius Institutes, and for other purposes; providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 7980) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to exclude vehicles the batteries of which contain materials sourced from prohibited foreign entities from the clean vehicle credit; providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 9456) to amend the Defense Production Act of 1950 with respect to foreign investments in United States agriculture, and for other purposes; and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 9494) making continuing appropriations for fiscal year 2025, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule 2 3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of 4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1398) to establish the CCP Initia-6 tive program, and for other purposes. The first reading 7 of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order 8 against consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one 9 hour equally divided and controlled by the chair and rank-10 ing minority member of the Committee on the Judiciary 11

or their respective designees. After general debate the bill 1 2 shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute 3 rule. In lieu of the amendment in the nature of a sub-4 stitute recommended by the Committee on the Judiciary 5 now printed in the bill, an amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Committee 6 7 Print 118–45 shall be considered as adopted in the House 8 and in the Committee of the Whole. The bill, as amended, 9 shall be considered as the original bill for the purpose of 10 further amendment under the five-minute rule and shall be considered as read. All points of order against provi-11 sions in the bill, as amended, are waived. No further 12 13 amendment to the bill, as amended, shall be in order except those printed in part A of the report of the Com-14 15 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each such further amendment may be offered only in the order print-16 17 ed in the report, may be offered only by a Member designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall 18 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally 19 20 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, 21 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be sub-22 ject to a demand for division of the question in the House 23 or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of order 24 against such further amendments are waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the 25

Committee shall rise and report the bill, as amended, to
the House with such further amendments as may have
been adopted. The previous question shall be considered
as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further
amendment thereto to final passage without intervening
motion except one motion to recommit.

7 SEC. 2. At any time after adoption of this resolution 8 the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule XVIII, 9 declare the House resolved into the Committee of the 10 Whole House on the state of the Union for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1425) to require any convention, agree-11 12 ment, or other international instrument on pandemic pre-13 vention, preparedness, and response reached by the World Health Assembly to be subject to Senate ratification. The 14 15 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consideration of the bill are waived. Gen-16 17 eral debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-18 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair 19 and ranking minority member of the Committee on For-20eign Affairs or their respective designees. After general de-21 bate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the 22 five-minute rule. An amendment in the nature of a sub-23 stitute consisting of the text of Rules Committee Print 24 118–44 shall be considered as adopted in the House and 25 in the Committee of the Whole. The bill, as amended, shall

be considered as the original bill for the purpose of further 1 2 amendment under the five-minute rule and shall be consid-3 ered as read. All points of order against provisions in the 4 bill, as amended, are waived. No further amendment to 5 the bill, as amended, shall be in order except those printed in part B of the report of the Committee on Rules accom-6 panying this resolution. Each such further amendment 7 8 may be offered only in the order printed in the report, 9 may be offered only by a Member designated in the report, 10 shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time specified in the report equally divided and controlled by 11 12 the proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to 13 amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division of the question in the House or in the Committee 14 15 of the Whole. All points of order against such further amendments are waived. At the conclusion of consider-16 17 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise 18 and report the bill, as amended, to the House with such further amendments as may have been adopted. The pre-19 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill, 20 21 as amended, and on any further amendment thereto to final passage without intervening motion except one mo-22 23 tion to recommit.

SEC. 3. At any time after adoption of this resolutionthe Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule XVIII,

declare the House resolved into the Committee of the 1 2 Whole House on the state of the Union for consideration 3 of the bill (H.R. 1516) to establish Department of Home-4 land Security funding restrictions on institutions of higher 5 education that have a relationship with Confucius Institutes, and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill 6 7 shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consid-8 eration of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-9 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-10 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on Homeland Security or their 11 12 respective designees. After general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute rule. In 13 lieu of the amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-14 15 ommended by the Committee on Homeland Security now printed in the bill pursuant to Part II of House Report 16 118-319, an amendment in the nature of a substitute con-17 18 sisting of the text of Rules Committee Print 118–46 shall be considered as adopted in the House and in the Com-19 mittee of the Whole. The bill, as amended, shall be consid-20 21 ered as the original bill for the purpose of further amend-22 ment under the five-minute rule and shall be considered 23 as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill, 24 as amended, are waived. No further amendment to the bill, 25 as amended, shall be in order except those printed in part

C of the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying 1 this resolution. Each such further amendment may be of-2 3 fered only in the order printed in the report, may be of-4 fered only by a Member designated in the report, shall 5 be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time specified in the report equally divided and controlled by the 6 7 proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amend-8 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division 9 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of order against such further amend-10 ments are waived. At the conclusion of consideration of 11 12 the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill, as amended, to the House with such further 13 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous 14 15 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further amendment thereto to final 16 passage without intervening motion except one motion to 17 18 recommit.

19 SEC. 4. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be 20 in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 7980) 21 to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to exclude 22 vehicles the batteries of which contain materials sourced 23 from prohibited foreign entities from the clean vehicle 24 credit. All points of order against consideration of the bill 25 are waived. The amendment in the nature of a substitute

recommended by the Committee on Ways and Means now 1 printed in the bill shall be considered as adopted. The bill, 2 3 as amended, shall be considered as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are 4 5 waived. The previous question shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further amend-6 7 ment thereto, to final passage without intervening motion 8 except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and con-9 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the 10 Committee on Ways and Means or their respective designees; and (2) one motion to recommit. 11

12 SEC. 5. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be 13 in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 9456) to amend the Defense Production Act of 1950 with respect 14 15 to foreign investments in United States agriculture, and for other purposes. All points of order against consider-16 17 ation of the bill are waived. The bill shall be considered 18 as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill 19 are waived. The previous question shall be considered as 20ordered on the bill and on any amendment thereto to final 21 passage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour 22 of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and 23 ranking minority member of the Committee on Financial 24 Services or their respective designees; and (2) one motion 25 to recommit.

1 SEC. 6. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be 2 in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 9494) making continuing appropriations for fiscal year 2025, 3 and for other purposes. All points of order against consid-4 5 eration of the bill are waived. The amendment printed in 6 part D of the report of the Committee on Rules accom-7 panying this resolution shall be considered as adopted. 8 The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. All 9 points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question shall be considered as 10 11 ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further 12 amendment thereto, to final passage without intervening 13 motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of 14 15 the Committee on Appropriations or their respective designees; and (2) one motion to recommit. 16
