Mr. SESSIONS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

**RESOLUTION**

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3442) to provide further means of accountability of the United States debt and promote fiscal responsibility, and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3293) to provide for greater accountability in Federal funding for scientific research, to promote the progress of science in the United States that serves that national interest.

- 1       *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this reso-  
2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule

1 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of  
2 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
3 ation of the bill (H.R. 3442) to provide further means of  
4 accountability of the United States debt and promote fis-  
5 cal responsibility. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-  
6 pensed with. All points of order against consideration of  
7 the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined to  
8 the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and  
9 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of  
10 the Committee on Ways and Means. After general debate  
11 the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-  
12 minute rule. The bill shall be considered as read. All points  
13 of order against provisions in the bill are waived. No  
14 amendment to the bill shall be in order except those print-  
15 ed in part A of the report of the Committee on Rules ac-  
16 companying this resolution. Each such amendment may  
17 be offered only in the order printed in the report, may  
18 be offered only by a Member designated in the report,  
19 shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time  
20 specified in the report equally divided and controlled by  
21 the proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to  
22 amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for divi-  
23 sion of the question in the House or in the Committee  
24 of the Whole. All points of order against such amendments  
25 are waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill

1 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the  
2 bill to the House with such amendments as may have been  
3 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
4 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage  
5 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit  
6 with or without instructions.

7       SEC. 2. At any time after adoption of this resolution  
8 the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule XVIII,  
9 declare the House resolved into the Committee of the  
10 Whole House on the state of the Union for consideration  
11 of the bill (H.R. 3293) to provide for greater account-  
12 ability in Federal funding for scientific research, to pro-  
13 mote the progress of science in the United States that  
14 serves that national interest. The first reading of the bill  
15 shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consid-  
16 eration of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-  
17 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-  
18 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority  
19 member of the Committee on Science, Space, and Tech-  
20 nology. After general debate the bill shall be considered  
21 for amendment under the five-minute rule. The bill shall  
22 be considered as read. All points of order against provi-  
23 sions in the bill are waived. No amendment to the bill shall  
24 be in order except those printed in part B of the report  
25 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution.

1 Each such amendment may be offered only in the order  
2 printed in the report, may be offered only by a Member  
3 designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall  
4 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally  
5 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,  
6 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be sub-  
7 ject to a demand for division of the question in the House  
8 or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of order  
9 against such amendments are waived. At the conclusion  
10 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee  
11 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such  
12 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous  
13 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and  
14 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening  
15 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-  
16 structions.
