RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 161) to provide for the timely consideration of all licenses, permits, and approvals required under Federal law with respect to the siting, construction, expansion, or operation of any natural gas pipeline projects, and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 36) to amend title 18, United States Code, to protect pain-capable unborn children, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 161) to provide for the timely consideration of all licenses,
4 permits, and approvals required under Federal law with
5 respect to the siting, construction, expansion, or operation
6 of any natural gas pipeline projects. All points of order
7 against consideration of the bill are waived. The bill shall
8 be considered as read. All points of order against provi-
9 sions in the bill are waived. The previous question shall
10 be considered as ordered on the bill and on any amend-
11 ment thereto to final passage without intervening motion
12 except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and con-
13 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the
14 Committee on Energy and Commerce; and (2) one motion
15 to recommit.

16 SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be
17 in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 36) to
18 amend title 18, United States Code, to protect pain-capable
19 unborn children, and for other purposes. All points of
20 order against consideration of the bill are waived. The bill
21 shall be considered as read. All points of order against
22 provisions in the bill are waived. The previous question
23 shall be considered as ordered on the bill and on any
24 amendment thereto to final passage without intervening
25 motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and

1 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of
2 the Committee on the Judiciary or their respective des-
3 ignees; and (2) one motion to recommit.
