Mr. COLLINS of Georgia, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5063) to limit donations made pursuant to settlement agreements to which the United States is a party, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this reso-
2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 5063) to limit donations made pur-

1 suant to settlement agreements to which the United States
2 is a party, and for other purposes. The first reading of
3 the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against
4 consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall
5 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-
6 ly divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minor-
7 ity member of the Committee on the Judiciary. After gen-
8 eral debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
9 under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider
10 as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under
11 the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-
12 stitute recommended by the Committee on the Judiciary
13 now printed in the bill. The committee amendment in the
14 nature of a substitute shall be considered as read. All
15 points of order against the committee amendment in the
16 nature of a substitute are waived. No amendment to the
17 committee amendment in the nature of a substitute shall
18 be in order except those printed in the report of the Com-
19 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each such
20 amendment may be offered only in the order printed in
21 the report, may be offered only by a Member designated
22 in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debat-
23 able for the time specified in the report equally divided
24 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall
25 not be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to

1 a demand for division of the question in the House or in
2 the Committee of the Whole. All points of order against
3 such amendments are waived. At the conclusion of consid-
4 eration of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise
5 and report the bill to the House with such amendments
6 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a
7 separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted
8 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the com-
9 mittee amendment in the nature of a substitute. The pre-
10 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
11 and amendments thereto to final passage without inter-
12 vening motion except one motion to recommit with or
13 without instructions.
