Mr. WOODALL, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 529) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to improve 529 plans; providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5) to support State and local accountability for public education, protect State and local authority, inform parents of the performance of their children's schools, and for other purposes; and for other purposes.

- 1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
- 2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.

1 529) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to im-
2 prove 529 plans. All points of order against consideration
3 of the bill are waived. The amendment in the nature of
4 a substitute recommended by the Committee on Ways and
5 Means now printed in the bill shall be considered as adopt-
6 ed. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. All
7 points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended,
8 are waived. The previous question shall be considered as
9 ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further
10 amendment thereto, to final passage without intervening
11 motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and
12 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of
13 the Committee on Ways and Means; and (2) one motion
14 to recommit with or without instructions.

15 SEC. 2. At any time after adoption of this resolution
16 the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule XVIII,
17 declare the House resolved into the Committee of the
18 Whole House on the state of the Union for consideration
19 of the bill (H.R. 5) to support State and local account-
20 ability for public education, protect State and local author-
21 ity, inform parents of the performance of their children's
22 schools, and for other purposes. The first reading of the
23 bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against
24 consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall
25 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-

1 ly divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minor-
2 ity member of the Committee on Education and the Work-
3 force. After general debate, the Committee of the Whole
4 shall rise without motion. No further consideration of the
5 bill shall be in order except pursuant to a subsequent order
6 of the House.

7 SEC. 3. The requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII
8 for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the Com-
9 mittee on Rules on the same day it is presented to the
10 House is waived with respect to any resolution reported
11 through the legislative day of March 2, 2015, relating to
12 a measure making or continuing appropriations for the
13 Department of Homeland Security for the fiscal year end-
14 ing September 30, 2015.

15 SEC. 4. It shall be in order at any time through the
16 calendar day of March 1, 2015, for the Speaker to enter-
17 tain motions that the House suspend the rules as though
18 under clause 1 of rule XV, relating to a measure making
19 or continuing appropriations for the Department of Home-
20 land Security for the fiscal year ending September 30,
21 2015.
