7 Ways and Means or his designee that the House concur
8 in the Senate amendment with the amendment printed in
9 the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this
10 resolution. The Senate amendment and the motion shall
11 be considered as read. The motion shall be debatable for
12 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair and
13 ranking minority member of the Committee on Ways and
14 Means. The previous question shall be considered as or-
15 dered on the motion to its adoption without intervening
16 motion or demand for division of the question.
