RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1304) to amend the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, the Public Health Service Act, and the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to exclude from the definition of health insurance coverage certain medical stop-loss insurance obtained by certain plan sponsors of group health plans.

- 1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
- 2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
- 3 1304) to amend the Employee Retirement Income Secu-

1 rity Act of 1974, the Public Health Service Act, and the
2 Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to exclude from the defini-
3 tion of health insurance coverage certain medical stop-loss
4 insurance obtained by certain plan sponsors of group
5 health plans. All points of order against consideration of
6 the bill are waived. The amendment in the nature of a
7 substitute recommended by the Committee on Education
8 and the Workforce now printed in the bill shall be consid-
9 ered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered
10 as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill,
11 as amended, are waived. The previous question shall be
12 considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any
13 further amendment thereto, to final passage without inter-
14 vening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally di-
15 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
16 member of the Committee on Education and the Work-
17 force; and (2) one motion to recommit with or without in-
18 structions.
