**RESOLUTION**

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1343) to direct the Securities and Exchange Commission to revise its rules so as to increase the threshold amount for requiring issuers to provide certain disclosures relating to compensatory benefit plans.

1       *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it  
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
3 1343) to direct the Securities and Exchange Commission  
4 to revise its rules so as to increase the threshold amount  
5 for requiring issuers to provide certain disclosures relating

1 to compensatory benefit plans. All points of order against  
2 consideration of the bill are waived. An amendment in the  
3 nature of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Com-  
4 mittee Print 115-11 shall be considered as adopted. The  
5 bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. All points  
6 of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are  
7 waived. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
8 dered on the bill, as amended, and on any further amend-  
9 ment thereto, to final passage without intervening motion  
10 except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and con-  
11 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the  
12 Committee on Financial Services; (2) the further amend-  
13 ment printed in the report of the Committee on Rules ac-  
14 companying this resolution, if offered by the Member des-  
15 ignated in the report, which shall be in order without  
16 intervention of any point of order, shall be considered as  
17 read, shall be separately debatable for the time specified  
18 in the report equally divided and controlled by the pro-  
19 ponent and an opponent, and shall not be subject to a  
20 demand for a division of the question; and (3) one motion  
21 to recommit with or without instructions.
